		2.4 National Redress Scheme (NRS)	MW	
		NRS has determined the club has financial capacity to meet its		
		estimated redress liabilities.		
		ME had provided a draft copy of 2023 financial statement		
		(same as final, but without the signature and explanatory notes of the auditor) along with her notes explaining our		
		commitments to boatshed refurbishment and extension.		
		MW concerned the determination may have been made		
		without full awareness of our 2023 financial situation with		
		recent significant write-down of our fixed assets (.i.e. we do not		
		own the club building) because email trail indicated the final		
		audited statement, with accompanying notes explaining the		
		asset write down / accounting changes, had not been sent.		
		MW had discussed this with lawyer David Williams (DW) and it		
		was agreed MW should clarify this ASAP with our NRS		
		Relationship Manager.		
		Pending matters for when ME returns includes signing of		
		Agreement to Participate (ATP) if not already sent? and		
		determining if any persons additional to ME need to be		
		identified for PRODA access.		
		Also to be considered is the nomination of a representative to the Redress Scheme Committee (RSC) which arises from our		
		categorisation as a group entity (as we have accepted		
		responsibility for the earlier non-incorporated version of our		
		club).		
		MW had also discussed this with DW and decision made to also		
		clarify with our NRS relationship manager the need for an RSC		
		representative given our categorisation as a group is a		
		technicality. Paddle WA has advised of an upcoming WA Parliamentary		
		Inquiry into aspects of the NRS experience in WA with its terms		
		of reference enabling the experience of involved institutions		
		(e.g. our club) to be considered. Deadline for any submissions is		
		August 4.		
		Paddle WA has offered to prepare a submission on our behalf		
		and had sent ME and MW a rough draft.		
		ME undecided on benefit if any of a Paddle WA submission and		
		does not want to make a personal submission. ME requested		
		matter be put to Committee in her absence. Committee decided it was not in favour of a Paddle WA		
		submission on our bobolf and that in NAT's absence MMA should
